

Video Interview Tips for Healthcare Travelers

Before the Interview

▼ Test your setup: Check the invite to see which platform the facility uses. Download the app and test your camera, mic, and Wi-Fi at least 30 minutes early.

Don't forget to allow access to your camera and microphone for the app. If you forget to do this, go to **Settings > Privacy > Camera/Microphone** to grant permission for the app you're using

- Using your phone? Prop it up horizontally, keep it steady, and plug it in.
- P Lighting: Face a window or use a ring light. Avoid bright light behind you.
- **Background:** Pick a clean space or click on one of our virtual backgrounds below.
- **!** Charge up: Keep your device plugged in throughout the call.
- Bonus Tip: Ask your recruiter for a quick test run before your interview.

They'll help you troubleshoot and feel more confident on camera!

- ▲ Bad Wi-Fi? Turn off your video or switch to audio-only.
